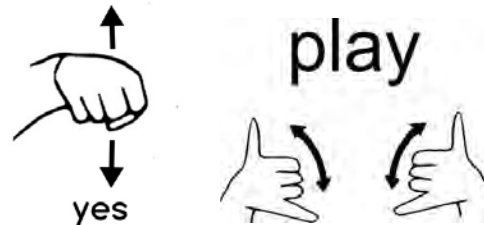


## Toddlers 2
